- 1) Please describe an important experience in your life and explain why it was important.
- 2) Name three people who you admire, living or dead, and tell why you admire them.
- 3) Why do you want to work with children?
- 4) Have you worked with children? In what capacity? What do you like most about being with them?
- 5) Is there anything you dislike about working with children?
- 6) Have you ever had to deal with children who needed discipline? What is your approach to disciplining children?
- 7) What would you do if you discovered that a child had stolen something highly valued that belonged to another child?



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- 8) In a few sentences, describe a child you have worked with or you know well.
- 9) What is your definition of love? How do you practice love?
- 10) What is your goal in life?
- 11) What would you describe as your strengths and your weaknesses? What are you doing to overcome your weaknesses?
- 12) Have you had any experience with community living or living with others who are not members of your family? What have you liked about it? What have you thought needed improvement?
- 13) Have you experienced violence? If so, how did you deal with it?
- 14) What do you do if an authority figure gives you a command that you do not agree with?
- 15) Describe what you expect to find at NPH.
- 16) What do you expect to gain from your experience as a volunteer?
- 17) What is your religious background and what does religion mean to you?
